**PICTURE DAY IS COMING** – The photographer will be here on Monday, September 19th to take photos of students in grade K4 – 7<sup>th</sup>. (8<sup>th</sup> graders will have their graduation photos taken in January.) All students may dress up for picture day, including the 8<sup>th</sup> grade. No order forms will be sent home until after proofs are available. Students should wear their Sunday best or their uniform. No t-shirts or jeans are allowed, nor clothes with rips or tears. Students that are dressed in attire deemed too tight, revealing, or short in length will call home for a change of clothes. We are looking forward to seeing our students SHINE on picture day!

**MEDICATION POLICY UPDATE** – A student may carry and self-administer an inhaler and/or Epi-Pen only with a doctor's orders and parent/guardian's consent. If it is deemed best to keep these items in the office, it will be kept in a locked cabinet. All student medication (including cough drops) must first be submitted to the front office for approval, with the proper St. Sebastian consent form on file and in its original packaging. Contact the office if you have questions or need a consent form for prescription medication.
