***Mission/Purpose: Our goal is to open our pantry and our hearts twice a month – with dignity, respect and love – and provide a two-to three-day emergency supply of food to those in need.***

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**When to Get Food:** Our pantry is open on the second and fourth Saturdays, from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. Shoppers can visit once or twice per month, depending on individual need.

**How to Get Food:** Each time shoppers visit, we ask that they bring legal identification (driver's license or state ID) AND a piece of mail (junk mail is fine) for each adult member of their household. For children, the preferred form of identification is a Forward card for each child.

**How to Give Food:** We much appreciate and depend on food drives, food donations, monetary donations, and bequests from fellow parishioners and other benefactors.

- **Food donations** may be made through food baskets in the worship spaces at St. Catherine and St. Sebastian Parishes, or by calling Rob Shelledy 414-477-3954.
- **Permanent requests** include canned tuna, canned chicken, macaroni & cheese, raw beans (pinto, black, kidney), raw white rice, pasta (all shapes/sizes), canned pork & beans, canned chili (meat or meatless), boxed cereal, oatmeal, pancake mix, canned fruit (mandarin oranges, fruit cocktail, applesauce), and canned vegetables (cut green beans, corn, tomatoes, white or sweet potatoes)
