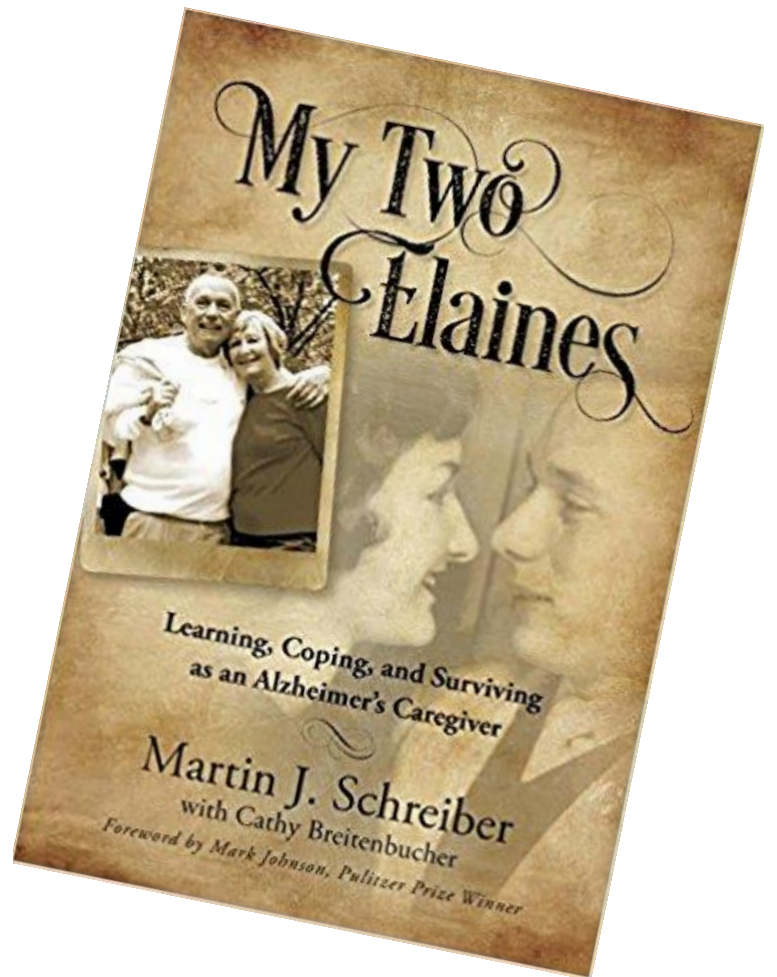


Gov. Martin Schreiber
