**Reading Incentive Program for students in grades 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>**

***If your child is in grades 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, PLEASE READ***

## **What is it?!**

ReadnQuiz is a reading incentive programs students in grades 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> are invited to enjoy! Students can read for pleasure and then quiz themselves on their reading. As students successfully pass quizzes, they earn points and are recognized for meeting point milestones.

## **How will students be recognized?**

The library will recognize students with Points Clubs. Each book has a number of points associated with it (ex: Cat in the Hat is 2 points; Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone is 16 points). As students successfully pass quizzes, they will accumulate points. Students will strive to attain certain point milestones throughout the year:

- 5 points
- 10 points
- 25 points
- 50 points
- 75 points
- 100 points
- Super Reader (500 + points)

As students reach a milestone they will receive recognition in the library, a number charm to add to a bookmark, name in the school newsletter, and certificate at the end of the year. Points will carry over each school year.

## **NEW!!! When can students quiz on books?**

We hope students will have the opportunity to quiz on books in your classroom as well as when they visit the library. **NEW THIS YEAR:** we are allowing students to quiz on books from home. We want students to not be limited with this *fun, incentive* program and we all know how busy the school day can be. Please see attached directions on how to quiz from home.

## **Rules about taking quizzes:**

- Students should select a book that is appropriate. They can use the "5 finger rule" when selecting a book which is taught in the library or their lexile reading range.
- Students should read (and hopefully enjoy!) the entire book.
- Students should NOT use the book when taking the quiz. The quiz asks for them to recall the information so NO open book quizzing.
- Students should work independently when taking a quiz.

Not every book has a quiz however ReadnQuiz quizzes cover a majority of the most popular books in school libraries.

- 97% of the most popular 1000 books
- 80% of the most popular 5000

Search for books to quiz on by searching by title, author, series, subject, or lexile level.
